The Founders

Andrea Eisel, born in 1963, has studied alternative educational concepts for a long time as a social, early childhood and Pikler educator. Among other things, she has developed several concepts and programs that give children of crèche and kindergarten age the opportunity to develop authentically and self-determinedly according to their abilities.

Markus Eisel, also born in 1963, holds a doctorate in natural sciences and is a successful entrepreneur. In both his scientific and industrial careers, he has seen time and again how important it is to have an education that enables people to act independently and make free decisions.

We both had the privilege of growing up in families that allowed us to choose our education and training freely. Political and social volunteering played a major role in this. Both in our professional lives and in our families, we were able to experience time and again that good education creates the foundations for people to lead self-designed, happy, healthy and contented lives.

Together we were able to build such a life for ourselves and our children. Through a lot of work and fortunate circumstances we have created the financial possibilities to establish this foundation. With this, we want to contribute to help and support children and young people in shaping their future by providing them with suitable educational opportunities.

The foundation

Together with a lawyer specializing in foundation law, we drew up the foundation's statutes for the purpose of promoting an education that actively involves children and young people in their educational processes as equal players every day. In addition to the statutes, we defined the funding criteria according to which our foundation allocates funds: The foundation operates purely as a funding foundation. Funding is provided for charitable projects, educational and training programs, and research projects that pursue and implement these approaches. Our support covers projects and offerings both in Germany and abroad, provided that the sponsors are recognized as non-profit in Germany or apply for non-profit status, see also <https://www.stiftung-zukunft-bilden.org/en/funding/>

We formed the board of directors, consisting of the two founders Andrea and Markus Eisel and their common daughter Lena Eisel.
